Union County residents can drop off the following items:

- ♻️ **Household Hazardous Waste (HHW):** paints, solvents, herbicides, pesticides, insecticides, cleaners, household chemicals, household batteries, cooking oil, grease and fluorescent bulbs
- ♻️ **Latex Paint:** -must be less than 3 years old -containers must be at least half full
-all paint cans must have secure lids -no leaky or rusty cans accepted
-paint must not have any solidification, cans may be checked and rejected
-if paint does not meet these criteria, please go to Union County Public Works website for disposal options
- ♻️ **Tires:** off the rim, limit 10 ♻️ **Batteries:** lead-acid batteries ♻️ **Motor Oil & Filters:** limit 5 gallons
- ♻️ **Paper Shredding Service:** shred your personal and financial documents, limit 5 boxes
- ♻️ **Electronics:** computers, laptops, printers, VCRs, mobile phones, TVs, microwaves, vacuums, electronic games, anything with an electric motor, plug or computer chip
